English Qualification Score Guarantee

- Eiken Grade 1 (or equivalent): English score guaranteed at 90%
- Eiken Pre-1 (or equivalent): English score guaranteed at 75%

□ [Important] Students wishing to participate in the one-year overseas study program must:

- Hold English proficiency equivalent to Eiken Pre-2 Plus (minimum 1,800 four-skill score) before applying.
- Achieve English proficiency equivalent to Eiken Grade 2 by July of their first year.
