

Helping Schools in Kenya

Education is one of the most important gifts that any country can give to its children. In some (16), especially rich nations, children can go to school for up to twelve years. But in poorer countries, going to school can be a challenge.

In Kenya, a country in east Africa, there is a big difference between the (17) experiences that the boys and girls have at elementary school. All children in that country should go to school, but only 67% of girls finish elementary school. This is because their families don't have enough money to pay for their education. Many of these girls have to stay at home or help their families to grow vegetables and take care of farm animals instead of (18).

The government of Kenya is trying to encourage girls to finish their education so that they can get good jobs and earn more (19). Girls who don't finish school have fewer chances in life than those who do. For example, girls who finish high school can earn twice as much money as girls who only have elementary school education, and those who go to university can make even more when they grow up to be women. They can use the money they earn to take care of their families and make sure that their own children have a good education one day.

Another problem with education in Kenya is that most teachers are men. Only 20% of elementary school teachers in the whole country are women, and this means that girls don't have good (20) role models to motivate them to study hard. A role model is an adult whom you respect and want to be like in the future. It's important for girls to have more female teachers so that they feel motivated to do their best at school.

The government of Kenya is planning to increase the number of female teachers in schools and support girls to make sure that they finish their education.

Working Together to Fight Influenza

Almost one billion people get sick from influenza every year. The illness causes headaches, a sore throat, tiredness, and many pains in our bodies. It can also make some people, especially older people, so sick that they need to go to hospital. Recently, many countries have decided to work together to fight influenza.

(22)At a conference in Hainan, China, scientists from many countries met to discuss the problems caused by influenza and how countries around the (23) should deal with the illness. The experts agreed that we should use data to check the number of people who catch influenza and also teach people about the disease and how to avoid catching it.

In some countries, doctors and hospitals keep details about patients with influenza and share this data with the government. Scientists can make a digital map of a city or a whole country that shows how many people have influenza and which places have the biggest number of sick people. (24) in these areas can get extra help from the government so that their patients get better soon. If all countries used this system, fewer people would get very sick from influenza.

Education is very important when it comes to preventing diseases like influenza and COVID-19. The government is trying to find a way to teach more people, especially children, about influenza and how to avoid catching it. Washing your hands often, wearing a mask when you are sick, and getting an influenza vaccine every year are three simple ways that can help many people to stay healthy.
