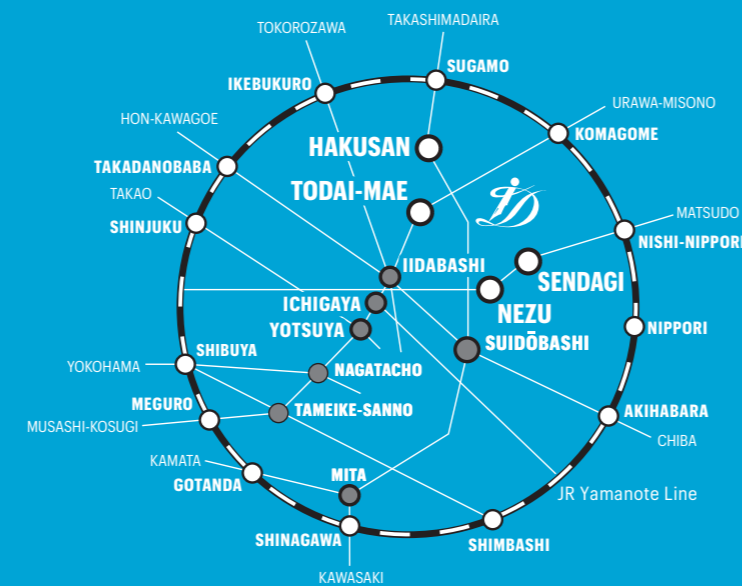

Introduction to Honors Class

Honors class is multicultural, with the majority of the student body comprising international students. In the class of 2029, 78% are international students from 22 countries and regions. Moreover, one in two teachers is an English speaker with a foreign nationality and background, and the official language of the class is English.

5 Key Features of Honors Class



1. English-Medium Education

All major academic subjects, except Japanese and practical subjects, are taught in English. For classes conducted in Japanese, handouts and assessments are provided in both English and Japanese to support student comprehension, particularly for international students.



Course Description

*An English-medium education is one that uses English as the primary medium of instruction, particularly where English is not the mother tongue of students.



2. Dual Diploma Program

In partnership with Wayland Academy, a distinguished U.S. preparatory school, enables students to complete online coursework and earn academic credit toward both Japanese and U.S. high school diplomas. This supports a smoother transition to international university applications.



Wayland Academy is a top U.S. boarding school known for its liberal arts and college preparatory programs.

Admission to at least one of Wayland Academy's partner universities is guaranteed, along with exclusive scholarships.

Number of Partner Universities of Wayland Academy

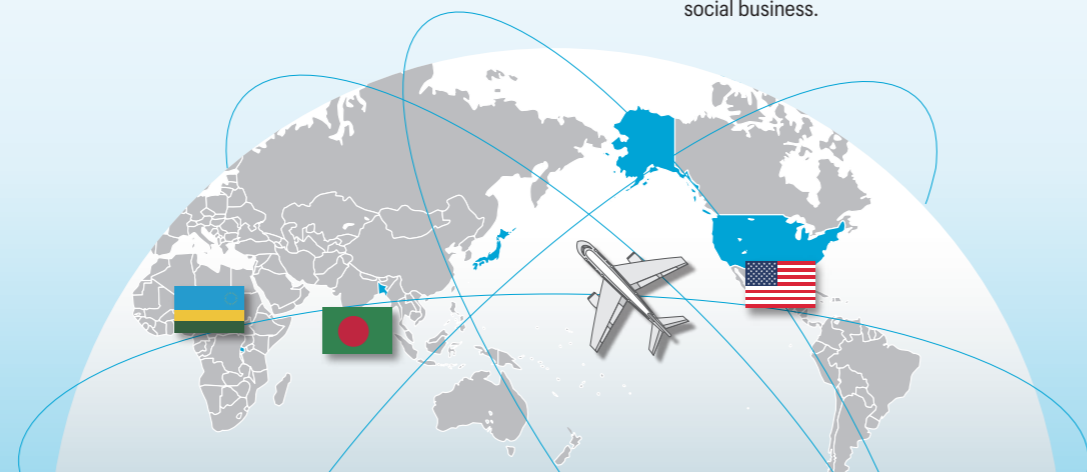

3. Unique Overseas Programs

Students will have the option either to study abroad in the United States for one year or to remain in Japan. Those who remain in Japan will be encouraged to participate in short-term overseas programs in the United States, Rwanda or Bangladesh.

- One-Year Study Abroad Program**
An immersive academic year at a local high school in the United States.
- Global South Program - Rwanda Course**
A field research trip to Rwanda, a leader in African ICT and nation-building.
- Silicon Valley Innovation Program**
A short-term intensive workshop held in the world's hub for technology and entrepreneurship.
- Global South Program - Bangladesh Course**
A social-action-focused program in Bangladesh, a country at the forefront of social business.



4. Distinctive University Guidance

University Information Sessions

We invite admissions officers from a variety of universities to hold information sessions on studying abroad. These sessions clearly explain how overseas universities differ from domestic ones, compare each country's admissions systems, and provide up-to-date scholarship information essential for international applications. In addition, we invite IGHS graduates studying abroad to share what campus life is really like and explain how the application process differs from Japan, offering a clear picture of international student life.

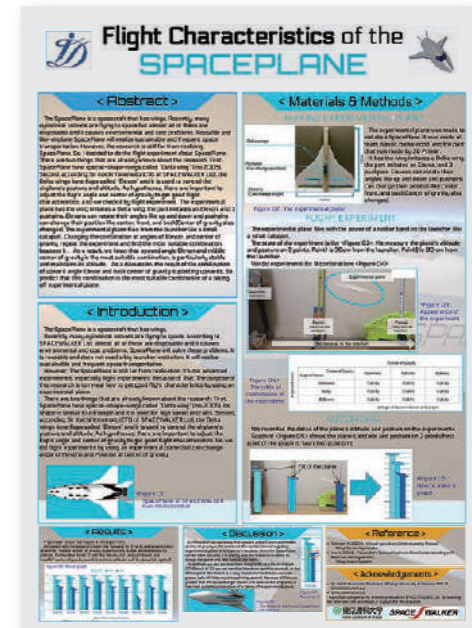
5. Applied Learning & SDGs Engagement

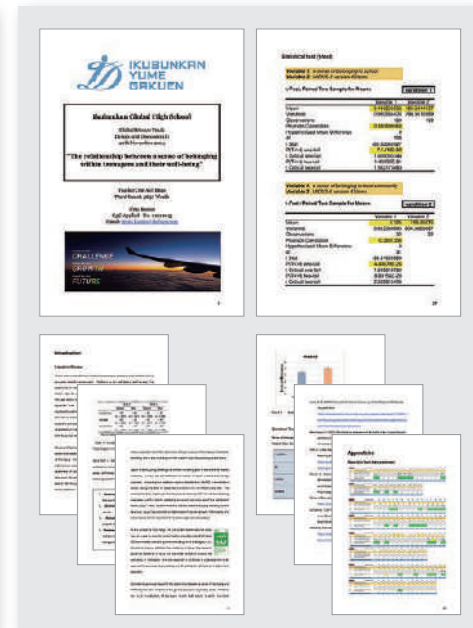
